Middle School

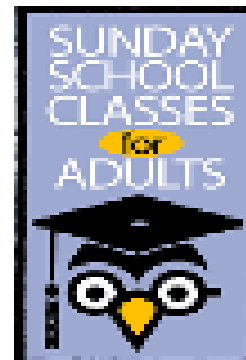
For 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students who have questions about life. This class addresses the issues that students face day-to-day with a biblical perspective, and an application to every day living.

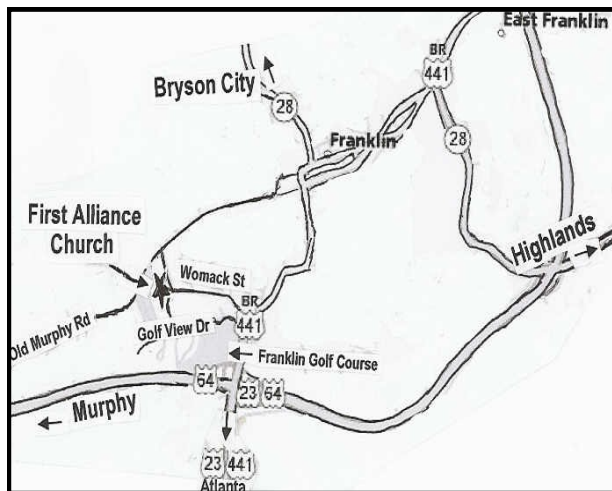
